ANT OUT[®] REFERENCE GUIDE

To control ants*, an effective strategy combines eliminating visible insects, cleaning surfaces, and then using ANT OUT[®] products strategically to disrupt ant trails and destroy colonies.



1 Sanitize and eliminate attractants

- Clean up crumbs, sugary spills and greasy residues immediately using soapy water or diluted vinegar on countertops and floors.
- Store room-temperature food in airtight containers.
- Do not leave overripe fruit exposed.
- Manage waste properly: use tightly fitted lids and clean bins regularly.
- Clean and dry all you put in the recycling bin.
- Repair leaks (sink, washbasin, dishwasher, etc.).
- Reduce moisture around baseboards and under sinks.

2 Seal and maintain the building envelope

- Caulk cracks and gaps around doors and windows.
- Check and seal openings around pipes and wiring.
- Replace damaged weather stripping.
- Adjust window screens.
- Trim vegetation and branches touching the house.
- Keep mulch and firewood away from siding.
- In winter, only bring indoors the firewood that will be burned within 24–48 hours.
- Inspect anything brought into the house (pool towels, laundry dried on the clothesline, toys, patio furniture stored in the basement, etc.).

Use ANT OUT® spray around doors and windows

WHY

To create a barrier that stops or exterminates ants.

WHERE

Spray around the bottom of doors and windows, both indoors and outdoors. Indoors, spray along baseboards, under sinks, and under and behind appliances. Outdoors, spray areas where ants are concentrated, along their trails, and on sidewalks, patios, decks, etc.

WHEN

At the first sign of activity and at the start of the season (spring), then again after heavy rain.

ACTION

The spray kills ants within 15 to 60 minutes and provides residual action lasting up to 2 weeks.

IMPORTANT

The insecticide will lose effectiveness more quickly when exposed to sunlight or rain. Repeat treatment only after 7 days if the infestation persists or if ants reappear.



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Use ANT OUT® Ant Killer with battery sprayer to treat large indoor or outdoor areas

WHY

To treat large surface areas and hard-to-access places indoors or outdoors, or to create a barrier around patios and entrances.

WHERE

Spray foundations, patios, decks, walkways, driveways and potential entry points.

ACTION

Kills ants within 15 to 60 minutes and offers a residual protection lasting up to 2 weeks.

IMPORTANT

The insecticide will lose effectiveness more quickly when exposed to sunlight or rain. Repeat treatment only after 7 days if the infestation persists or reappears.

ANT OUT® Ant Stakes for lawns and gardens

WHY

Garden bait stations that generally eliminate the colony within 7 days.

WHERE

In flower gardens, lawns, near walkways, patios, steps, decks, foundations, garages and sheds.

ACTION

Long-lasting effect that eliminates entire ant colonies within 7 days.

TIP

Install stakes near anthills. Replace every 30 days during the summer season to eliminate new ant colonies that may become established.



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Use ANT OUT® Ant & Roach Aerosol Killer to control insects indoors and outdoors

WHY

To create a barrier that stops ants or to reach hard-to-access areas.

WHERE

Apply in cracks, crevices, and other hard-to-reach places. Also treat the bottom of doors and windows, foundations, soffits and any visible gaps (pavers, patios, porches, etc.).

WHEN

At the first sign of activity and at the start of the season (spring), then again after heavy rain.

ACTION

After application, no insects will be visible for up to two weeks. (Residual effect may last up to 60 days for roaches.)

Use ANT OUT® Jet Foam Ant Killer to treat and eliminate nests

WHY

To eliminate nests hidden in hard-to-reach areas.

WHERE

Apply in cracks, crevices and visible nests. Insert the extension tube as far as possible into mounds, cracks, crevices and gaps in walkways, patios, sidewalks, pavers, etc. where ants are hiding. Spray until the foam fills the entire space and rises to the surface. For outdoor use.

WHEN

As soon as the first signs confirming the presence of ants appear.

ACTION

Kills ants on contact and provides residual protection on treated surfaces.



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Apply ANT OUT® Ant Killer Dust indoors and outdoors

WHY

To create a barrier and reach harder-to-access areas.

WHERE

Indoors, apply in cracks, behind baseboards, around pipes and under appliances. Outdoors, apply near doors and windows, on sidewalks, patios, decks, porches and around foundations. Reapply after rain or when the dust is no longer visible.

ACTION

Kills ants within 48 hours.

BENEFIT

Effective as long as it remains present, the dust easily treats hard-to-reach places. Diatomaceous earth-based product, non-toxic to humans and pets.



Install ANT OUT® Traps

WHY

To destroy an entire colony. Worker ants will carry the bait back to the nest, eliminating the entire colony.

WHERE

Place baits along visible trails and near entry points, out of reach of children and pets. For indoor and outdoor use.

ACTION

Its slow action allows worker ants to carry the bait back to the nest, where it spreads throughout the colony and eliminates it within 3 to 7 days.

TIP

Do not spray insecticide directly on ant trails once baits are in place, to avoid repelling ants and preventing them from carrying the bait back to the nest.

SIMPLE 3-STEP METHOD



1

LOCATE

Follow the trail to the suspected entry point.

2

SANITIZE

Clean the trail with soap and water (or diluted vinegar) to erase pheromones.

3

TREAT

Indoors:

Traps near trails, dust in crevices and insecticide spray on door thresholds and window frames.

Outdoors:

Battery sprayer to treat large areas, foam to eliminate nests, aerosol for cracks and hard-to-reach areas, as well as stakes and traps along visible trails.



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SAFETY AND EFFECTIVENESS TIPS



- Follow the directions on the packaging for each product.
- Respect indoor/outdoor use areas.
- Avoid contaminating food contact surfaces; treat only when surfaces are cleared.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Avoid inhaling dust products and ventilate after spraying.
- Be patient with baits! Leave bait stations in place for several days. Do not move them if you observe activity.

WHEN TO REPEAT TREATMENT OR HIRE A PROFESSIONAL



- If activity persists for more than 10 days, reposition bait stations along new trails and renew perimeter treatment.
- If you observe winged ants emerging from inside the house or an unusually high volume of ants, contact a professional.

*ANT OUT® is effective against all ants except carpenter ants, which require professional treatment.



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
